

ORDINANCE NO. 1043

AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING THE USE OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 1012 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1016.


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Between April 15 and October 15 of each year, users of City of Prineville water for irrigation shall comply with the following restrictions:
 - A. Irrigation shall be permitted before 10 a.m. and after 4 p.m. but shall be prohibited in the hours between.
 - B. Irrigation shall be defined as watering trees, lawns, soil, bushes, flowers, plants or other vegetation by any means, including but not limited to sprinklers, hand held hoses or ditches.
2. The City Manager may restrict all use of city water for irrigation purposes upon any emergency situation or for essential purposes.
3. Violators shall be fined not more than \$100 for each violation.
4. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.
5. Ordinance No. 1012 and Ordinance No. 1016 are hereby repealed in their entirety.
