

ORDINANCE NO. 1112

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSE RECOMMENDATION FEES

WHEREAS, The Oregon Liquor Control Commission requires every applicant seeking a license to manufacture, distribute, take orders for and sell spirits, wines, beer, and other alcoholic liquors in the City of Prineville to obtain a recommendation on said application from the Prineville City Council; and

WHEREAS, the current fees charged by the City of Prineville do not cover such processing costs; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held concerning raising the fees for processing the written recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


1. Every applicant seeking a license to manufacture, distribute, take orders for and sell spirits, wines, beer, and other alcoholic liquor within the City of Prineville shall pay to the City of Prineville according to the following schedule:

<u>Type of Application</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Original application	\$100.00
Change in ownership, change in location or change in privilege application	\$ 75.00
Renewal or temporary application	\$ 35.00


2. The above fees are reasonable and necessary to pay the City's expenses in processing the written recommendation to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.
