

RESOLUTION NO. 1159

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 1157 REGARDING CHANGES IN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CROOK COUNTY ENTERPRISE ZONE

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville ("City") and Crook County ("County") are sponsors of the Crook County Enterprise Zone ("Zone"); and

WHEREAS, the Zone manager requested adding 974.85 acres of real property to the Zone; and

WHEREAS, in order to change the boundaries of an enterprise zone the Oregon Business Development Department needs to receive boundary change requests from both sponsors; and

WHEREAS, City believed City and County had agreed on the real property to be added to the Zone; and


WHEREAS, City passed Resolution No. 1157 requesting 974.85 acres of real property be added to the Zone; and

WHEREAS, County passed Order and Resolution No. 2011-28 requesting 447.05 acres of real property be added to the Zone; and

WHEREAS, since the City's Resolution No. 1157 and County's Order and Resolution No. 2011-28 are inconsistent, City desires to repeal Resolution No. 1157 and pass another Resolution consistent with County's order and Resolution No. 2011-28;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Prineville resolves that Resolution No. 1157 is hereby repealed effective immediately.
