

**ORDINANCE NO. 1258**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHANGES TO PRINEVILLE CODE SECTIONS  
50.15(B)(1) AND 50.16**

**Whereas**, on January 14, 2020, the City of Prineville City Counsel, following a public hearing, which was publicly noticed, adopted Resolution 1421 approving the transfer of the solid waste franchise agreement from Holiday Enterprises, LLC (“Holliday”) to Allied Waste Transfer Services of Oregon, LLC, dba Republic Services of Oregon (“Republic”).

**Whereas**, Holliday and Republic have executed appropriate transfer documents that were filed with the City Recorder.

**Whereas**, City of Prineville Code Chapter 50 must be amended to appropriately reflect the transfer.

**Whereas**, this Ordinance was available to the public at least one week before its presentation to the City Council.

**Whereas**, the Ordinance requires to be effective immediately and therefore an emergency clause is required.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Section 50.15(B)(1) and 50.16 are amended to read as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.
2. This ordinance is effective immediately.

Presented for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Council held on January 28, 2020, and unanimously passed hereto.
