### Issue Summary

Topic; Summer Overlay Bid Award

#### Overview;

The Transportation Department has solicited and received bids for their 2007-2008 summer overlay project. This project consists of a total of 957 tons of asphalt. The streets that will be resurfaced are W 1<sup>st</sup> from Deere to Main. W 1<sup>st</sup> from Dunham to Fairview. SE 5<sup>th</sup> from Juniper to Knowledge and a small section of Knowledge St. Staff would like to inform the Council that this overlay will be slightly different from previous overlays. This overlay will begin 6' from the face of the curb and extend to within 6' of the opposite curb face. The reasons for these parameters are to not adversely affect our storm water drainage at the curb line and to extend the lineal footage of the overlay.

The City of Prineville received bids from 3 of Central Oregon's paving contractors. The bids are as follows; Harney Rock-\$63.84/ton Knife River-\$64.14/ton High Desert-\$67.40/ton



Staff Recommendation;

Staff requests that the Council award the summer overlay bid to; Harney Rock & Paving for \$63.84 per ton

Budgetary Considerations;

Payment for this bid award will be deducted from fund 10, line item 10-43100-6240 transportation improvements which has a current total of \$90500.00

Staff anticipates using the remainder of this line item in a spring overlay bid award once it has accessed winter damage.
