

§ 33.01 AUTHORITY TO DISPOSE OF PROPERTY.

Whenever the Chief of the Police Department has sufficient property to make the sale thereof financially feasible, in his/her possession, the ownership of which is unknown, and which is unclaimed for 30 days after the property came into his/her possession, he/she shall request authority to dispose of it as provided in this

subchapter.
