City Council Meeting Brief April 13th, 2010

Additions to the Agenda

A revised agenda was distributed which reflected addition of an Intent to Award 2nd Street Water Main Replacement and removal of Humane Society appearance.

Consent Agenda

Councilor Roppe made a motion to approve Consent Agenda. Motion seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Visitors, Appearances and Requests:

- A. Kevin Gaboury reporter for the Central Oregonian came forward and explained to Council that he had accepted a job with another newspaper in Idaho. Mr. Gaboury added that he couldn't have asked for a better first job and recognized Council and staff for helping with that. Council thanked him for attending all of the meetings and wished him well.
- B. Sharon Vail, Interim Executive Director of Rimrock Health Alliance explained the purpose of the Alliance. Stating that they would like to strengthen the economy and their goal to bring together all healthcare providers, suppliers, and schools. The Alliance will also be busy recruiting doctors to come to Prineville and be a part of the

community. Rimrock Health Alliance would also like to serve as a medical chamber of commerce.

Ms. Vail introduced Bob Gomes, CEO of Pioneer Memorial Hospital.

Mr. Gomes came forward and provided some background and family information.

Steve Forrester stated that: Jerry Brummer, Public Works Superintendent, Eric Klann, City Engineer and Steve Forrester met with Wayne Kinney from Senator Wyden's office and was optimistic regarding appropriations for design of wetland project; 2nd Street old Crooked River bridge has been removed and the 2nd Street egress moving forward; Associated Press will be doing article on Prineville and Facebook; Liz Schuette, Finance Director and Steve Forrester are right on target with budget; Wayne VanMatre is back in town; a consultant expense summary was distributed to Council; golf course windmill has been installed to aerate the ponds to promote oxygen circulation and reduce odor.
