# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF A 2010 FUND EXCHANGE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the City of Prineville applied to the State of Oregon Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for a fund exchange through the Surface Transportation Program, which provides funding through federal gas tax programs to be used for transportation related expenses. The City's application requests reimbursement for the following 2009 projects: crack sealing project, fall asphalt overlay, Tenth and Main Street signal upgrade, spring gravel purchase, and winter gravel purchase for a total of \$194,834.28; and


WHEREAS, ODOT has approved the City's application and has agreed to provide \$194,834.28 to the City for reimbursement of the above described 2009 transportation related projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the City of Prineville approve the 2010 Fund Exchange Agreement between the City and ODOT known as miscellaneous contract and agreement No. 26717 and that the Mayor and City Manager are authorized to sign such Agreement on behalf of the City of Prineville.

Topic: ODOT Fund Exchange Agreement (Surface Transportation Program)

Action Requested: Council's Approval for Signature

#### Summary:

Staff has applied to ODOT for fund exchange through the (STP) Surface Transportation Program. This program provides funding through the Federal gas tax program to states and local governments which can be used strictly for transportation related expenses. The City of Prineville applied via project prospectus to access both 2009 and 2010 allocations and the application has been approved and a 2010 Fund Exchange Agreement, (No.26717) issued.

The 2009 and 2010 account balance for the City of Prineville totals \$207,271.00 Federal dollars. Through the fund exchange program the City provides documents pertaining to completed transportation projects and then receives \$.94 cents on the dollar in State dollars.

The City of Prineville proposed and received approval for reimbursement on the following projects:
