Downtown Strategic Plan (DSP) Committee Grant Program.

This memorandum is an update on the Downtown Strategic Plan (DSP) Committee Grant Program. At the last DSP Committee, the Committee ranked the 6 grant applications that were received for the downtown enhancement grant program. The projects were ranked 1 to 6 by the committee.

As you may recall, the City Council has budgeted \$10,000.00 annually for the last two for this program. The maximum award is \$2,500.00 at a 50% match which means the project would need to cost in excess of \$5,000.00 to qualify for the maximum \$2,500.00 grant.

This year six applications were received for a total of \$10,884.25 with the DSP Committee recommending an expenditure of \$10,396.75. Once again, the Chamber of Commerce is proposing to partner with the City to fund all six projects if approved by the City. The Chamber has indicated it will pay the stop gap of \$396.75. The applications are attached for your review and the ranking from the Committee are listed below.
