

**RESOLUTION NO. 1366  
CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING POLICY OF CITY OF PRINEVILLE REGARDING  
EXCESSIVE FORCE IN NONVIOLENT CIVIL RIGHTS DEMONSTRATIONS**

**Whereas**, the United States Congress passed the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (“Act”), which authorizes Community Development Block Grants (CDBG); and

**Whereas**, the Act requires recipients of CDBG funds to comply with certain regulations and requirements, including an affirmation that any governing body’s police force will follow all applicable state and local laws regarding nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and

**Whereas**, the City of Prineville (“City”) is a recipient of a CDBG for the renovation of the Prineville Senior Center;

**Now, Therefore**, the City of Prineville resolves that it is the policy of the City that:

1. Its law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and
2. Applicable state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.
