Steve Forrester, City Manager stated that there is a public hearing prior to considering Resolution No. 1229.

Council Business:

A. If I Were Mayor Contest Prizes – Mayor Roppe

A. Managers' Report – Steve Forrester

Mr. Forrester stated: the 2nd Airport Master Plan meeting was held; staff held meetings with Brooks Resources and the School District to extend Combs Flat Road and that project will begin tomorrow; the city helped facilitate agreement on the sewer project for Ochoco Lumber site; Matt Weiderholt traveled to Iowa to inspect the new locomotive which should be here at the end of March or first of April; had meeting with Larry Patterson regarding an outline for the Council Strategic Plan; Friday is the League of Oregon Cities Board meeting which I will be attending as a board member; we will be getting legislative updates at this meeting; and Mary Puddy, Human Resource Director and Captain Boyd have been working on an Emergency Continuity Plan.

Councilor Carr had questions regarding the Combs Flat Road extension project.

Eric Klann, City Engineer stated that most of the construction will take place on site and construction traffic will not go through the residential areas of Iron Horse and the project should be completed by the first of June.
