ORDINANCE NO. 578

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY IN CROOK COUNTY, OREGON BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, heretofore a petition was duly presented to the City Council for the alteration of the present boundaries of the City and the inclusion therein of contiguous new territory particularly described as follows:

Lot 1, Block 4, East Riverside Addition Lot 2, Block 4, East Riverside Addition and

That portion of Lots 11 and 12, Block 12, Oregon and Western Addition now outside the City Limits of Prineville

all as appears on the plat of **E.** Riverside Addition and the plat of Oregon and Western Addition to Prineville, Oregon which are on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk for Crook County, Oregon

AND 'EREAS, the City Council did dispense with the submitting of the question of such alteration of the boundaries of the City and inclusion of said contiguous new territory to the registered voters of said City, and did fix a day for the public hearing before the Council, at which time the registered voters of the City could appear and be heard on the question of such annexation, and did cause due notice of the time and place of such hearing to be published once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for the hearing in the Central Oregonian, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Prineville, and did cause notice of such hearing to be posted in four public places in the City of Prineville for a like period, all as more fully appears from the affidavit of the publisher of said newspaper, and the affidavit of the Recorder of the City of Prineville, both of which affidavits are on file in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Prineville,

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice, said hearing was duly had and no objection made by any person to the alteration of the boundaries of the City by the annexation of the contiguous new territory above described,

AND WHEREAS, it further appears that the owners of all of said contiguous territory proposed to be annexed have duly consented in writing to such annexation, which consent is on file in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Prineville,

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the said real property as above described be and it is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Prineville, and its boundaries are hereby altered to include the same within the City of Prineville.
