

ORDINANCE NO. 580

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 571, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, CONVERSION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND/OR STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AS THE BUILDING CODE OR ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE (1964 EDITION) OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 491 AND ORDINANCE NO. 548; AND DECLARING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE DISTRICTS AS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 492".

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 571 shall be amended to read as follows:

Before receiving a building permit, the owner or his agent shall pay the City Recorder-Treasurer the following fees:

<u>Total Valuation</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Less than \$50.00	No Fee
\$50.00, to and including \$400	\$ 3.00
More than \$400, to and including \$1,000	5.00
Each additional \$1,000, or fraction, to and including \$25,000	2.00
Each additional \$1,000, or fraction, to and including \$50,000	1.50
Each additional \$1,000, or fraction, to and including \$100,000	1.00
Each additional \$1,000 or fraction, more than \$100,000	.50
For moving or demolishing a building	2.00

The City, County, State and Federal governments shall not be required to pay a building permit fee. (Also, churches shall not be required to pay a permit fee for building permits issued for houses of worship. This exemption shall not apply to church-owned buildings which are constructed separate and apart from the buildings in which regular ceremonies of worship are conducted.)
