

ORDINANCE NO. 587

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 427 BY REVISING RATES CHARGED FOR TAXICAB FARES, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 13 of Ordinance No. 427 shall be amended to read as follows:

The following schedule of rates shall be charged and collected for the transportation of passengers within the city by all persons, firms or corporations owning and operating licensed taxicabs, and no different rates shall at any time be charged or collected for taxicab service, either directly or indirectly, ~~th~~ through the use of coupons, rebates, commutation tickets or in any other manner. A taxi meter shall be installed in each taxicab and the meters shall be set at the following rates:

50¢ for the first 2/3 mile-

10¢ each additional 1/3 mile

10¢ each 3rd, 4th and 5th passenger

5¢ per minute waiting time

Waiting time shall include the time when the taxicab is not in motion, beginning with the time of arrival at the place to which the taxicab has been called, or the time consumed while the taxicab is standing at the direction of the passenger. No charge shall be made for the time lost on account of inefficiency of the taxicab, or its operation, or time consumed by premature response to a call.

The foregoing schedule of rates shall be conspicuously posted or placed in each taxicab and in such a manner that said rates may be easily read from both the inside and the outside of each taxicab. The rates shall be headed with the word "RATES" in letters of not less than one-half of an inch in length, and the text thereof shall be in letters not less than twelve point type, printed or painted on cards not less than 4"x6" in size.

No charge shall be made for traveling empty, whether going or returning.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
