ORDINANCE NO. 6//
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A MUNICIPAL JUDGE OF THE CITY OF PRIME-VILLE, PRO TEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Prineville, Oregon, do hereby ordain as follows:

- najority vote, appoint a qualified person to act on a continuing basis as municipal judge pro tem, to act as such in the absence, disability or disqualification of the municipal judge; the City Council may further, by a majority vote, from time to time, appoint a qualified person to act as municipal judge pro tem to conduct the trial of a specified matter or to act in such capacity for a specified time, the same to be done in the event that the municipal judge and the existing judge pro tem, if any, be both disqualified or unable to act in a particular matter or at a particular time or times.
- 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect by its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
- 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
