

ORDINANCE NO. 614

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 568 TO PROHIBIT KEEPING DANGEROUS OR VENOMOUS REPTILES WITHIN THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 568 shall be amended to read as follows:


Section 3. DANGEROUS ANIMALS OR REPTILES. No person may permit a wild or domesticated dangerous animal to run at large. No person may keep any dangerous or venomous reptile in captivity, or transport any snake into the City of Prineville.

Section 2. Inasmuch as a situation has arisen which appears to threaten the peace and safety of the people of Prineville in that venomous snakes are being kept in the City and it is possible that these snakes could be released accidentally, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
