

ORDINANCE NO. 621

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF COMMERCIAL PARKING PERMITS

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That commercial parking permits be made available to carpenters, plumbers, electricians, painters or other workmen who are required to park their vehicles in the area where parking meters are installed, or to owners of vehicles whose business requires frequent stops in the metered area for the purpose of picking up or delivering articles of goods or merchandise.


Section 2. That application for a commercial parking permit shall be made to the City Council on a form which states the name and address of the applicant, the type of business in which the applicant is engaged, the purpose for which the parking permit is sought, and the license number of the vehicle on which the parking permit would be used.

Section 3. That a charge of \$ 20⁰⁰ per year, or \$ 10⁰⁰ for six months shall be made, for each commercial parking permit.

Section 4. That a commercial parking permit shall be used only for the purpose stated in the application for the permit, and use of a parking permit for personal purposes shall result in revocation of the parking permit. If a parking permit is revoked, there shall be no refund of the fee paid for the permit.
