ORDINANCE NO. 638

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CICTION 13, OF ORDINANCE NO. 564, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING OFFENSES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 71, 93, 149, 163, 170, 257 and 319." PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR AUGUST 26, 1964. PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF MERCHANDISE ON SIDEWALKS WITH PERMISSION OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 13 of Ordinance No. 564 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor, August 26, 1964 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 13. Obstructing passageways.

- (1) No person may, except as otherwise permitted by ordinance or with permission of the City Council, obstruct, cause to be obstructed or assist in obstructing pedestrians or vehicular traffic on any sidewalk or street.
- (2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to the delivery of merchandise or equipment, provided that no person may permit such merchandise or equipment to remain on any street or sidewalk beyond a reasonable time.
- (3) No person may permit any merchandise, equipment or other obstruction to remain on any street or sidewalk, without first obtaining permission from the City Council.
- (4) No person may use the street or sidewalk or any portion thereof for selling, storing or displaying merchandise or equipment except as may otherwise be provided by ordinance or <u>first obtaining permission</u> from the City Council.
- (5) No unauthorized person may deposit any earth or gravel, or debris upon any street or sidewalk.
