

ORDINANCE NO. 644

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 50 OF ORDINANCE NO. 562 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL" PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OCTOBER 24, 1964, PROVIDING FOR AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF 50 CENTS TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE BEFORE EACH LICENSE OR RENEWAL THEREOF IS GRANTED.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 50 of Ordinance No. 562, passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor October 24, 1964 is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 50. License Required

No person who resides within this city, shall ride or propel a bicycle on any street or upon any public path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles unless such bicycle has been licensed. Applications for such license shall be made to the Chief of Police who may issue a license which shall be effective until the first day of January of the year following, providing the applicant submits satisfactory proof of ownership of the bicycle and evidences reasonable knowledge of traffic safety rules. An annual license fee of 50 cents shall be paid to the City of Prineville before each license or renewal thereof is granted.

Now, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the City Council, and approval by the Mayor.
