ORDINANCE NO. 662

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY ABUTTING SOUTH PRINEVILLE ADDITION AND RIVERSIDE ADDITION AND DISPENSING WITH A CITY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Prineville a written proposal for annexation to the City by more than two-thirds of the landowners who also own more than two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory described below which real property therein represents more than two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 661 was passed, initiating the annexation of said territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon, and since the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the City Council and since that body feels that annexation is to the best interest of the City and of the contiguous territory; now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following described contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Prineville:

Beginning at the southeast corner of South Prineville Addition, Prineville, Oregon, thence west 794.36 feet along the south line of South Prineville Addition to the east line of Riverside Addition; thence south 387 feet along said east line to the center of Crooked River; thence east 50 feet along said centerline; thence north 58 feet; thence east 744.36 feet to the west boundary of South Main Street; thence north 329 feet along said west boundary to the point of beginning containing 6.07 acres and subject to all existing rights of way and easements.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State (1) a copy of this ordinance, (2) a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in the territory annexed, and (3) a copy of Ordinance No. 661 dispensing with an election in the City on the question of annexation. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds, or legal subdivisions, of the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the effective date of annexation to the Crook County Assessor and Crook County Clerk.
