

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF DISPOSAL OF SEPTIC TANK WASTES INTO THE CITY SEWER SYSTEM, FIXING CHARGES FOR SUCH DISPOSAL, AND PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF SUCH CHARGES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The dumping of any septic tank wastes shall be permitted only at the City sewage treatment plant at a point designated by the City.

Section 2. Permission for dumping shall be granted by the City Administrator. Such permission shall be granted only to pumpers licensed under the provisions of Chapter IX of Rules Pertaining to Standards for Subsurface Sewage and Non-Water Carried Waste Disposal, as adopted by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, April, 1974.

Section 3. The City Administrator shall have the right to revoke permission to dump for any violation of the provisions herein contained. An appeal from a ruling of the City Administrator may be made only to the City Council.

Section 4. The pumper shall first secure the approval of a designated City official prior to dumping any load. At the time of obtaining this approval the pumper will be given a bill showing the amount of material to be dumped, date and time, and charge therefore.

Section 5. Only domestic-type wastes shall be discharged into the City system. Under no circumstances will oil, rocks, or other damaging materials be discharged into the system. If the above is violated at any time, the pumper shall be responsible for any clean-up, repair, or damage of any nature to City property resulting from such illegal discharge.

Section 6. The discharge shall be made only through a hose or other approved type of outlet.

Section 7. Such dumping of septic tank wastes shall be done only between the hours of 8:30 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, unless with permission granted herein and necessitated by a bonafide emergency.

Section 8. The pumper using City facilities shall be responsible for cleaning the immediate area at the conclusion of each dumping and shall leave the discharge manhole in a clean and sanitary condition.


Section 9. The charge for dumping of septic tank wastes shall be \$5.00 per each dumping.


Section 10. All payments shall be made to the City Recorder's office by the pumper prior to the dumping of each load. The plant operator will not accept payment at the treatment plant.

Section 11. All funds collected under this ordinance shall accrue to the benefit of the City Sewer Fund.
