ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.050 OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1968 AND THEREFORE EFFECTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PRINEVILLE ZONING MAP.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2.280. Zone Change. Section 2.050 of the City of Prineville Zoning Ordinance of 1968 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection.


(23) That territory described as tax lots 300, 400, 401, 402, 500, 600, 700, and 800 of Crook County Assessor's Map 15-16-5A and located within the boundaries indicated by a red line on the Prineville City Zoning Map Amendment No. A(M)-23 as approved by the Prineville City Planning Commission on the 16th day of November, 1976, and which map amendment bears the signature of the Secretary of the City Planning Commission, is hereby reclassified from General Residential R-2 to Outlying Commercial C-2.
