AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY HERETOFORE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON FROM THE CROOK COUNTY VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT AND CROOK COUNTY ZONE II FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, certain real property and territory was annexed by the City of Prineville by Ordinance No. 769 and subsequently clarified by Ordinance No. 776, and

WHEREAS, the territory annexed by the above listed ordinance is located within the boundaries of Crook County Vector Control District and the Crook County Zone II Fire District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 779, the City Council held a public hearing for the purpose of hearing any objections to the withdrawl of the property mentioned from the the public service districts mentioned;

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Withdrawl</u>. The City Council determined that the territory within the boundaries of the Crook County Vector Control District and the Crook County Zone II Fire District heretofore incorporated as or annexed to the City of Prineville by Ordinance No. 769 and subsequently clarified by Ordinance No. 776, is hereby withdrawn from the Crook County Vector Control District and the Crook County Zone II Fire District.

Section 2. <u>Liabilities</u>. Neither the City nor the part withdrawn shall be charged by the Crook County Vector Control District and the Crook County Zone II Fire District with any future liabilities, obligations, or functions of the districts.
