

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY ITS CORPORATE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is surrounded by the corporate limits or boundaries of the City of Prineville and is not an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City and the proposed area that the territory described below be annexed to the City pursuant to ORS 222.750 without an election in the City; now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PRINEVILLE, OREGON, ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexed Territory. The following described territory which is surrounded by the City boundaries is hereby annexed to the City of Prineville:

- A. Harding Street bordered on the South by U.S. Hwy. 26 and on the North by Laughlin Road.
- B. Hudspeth Road bordered on the South by Laughlin Road and on the North by Ochoco Avenue.
- C. Juniper Street bordered on the South by the Center of the Juniper Street Bridge over Ochoco Creek and on the North by Laughlin Road.

Section 2. Record. The City recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State of Oregon, the Crook County Assessor, and the Crook County Clerk a copy of this ordinance.
