

RESOLUTION NO. 863

A Resolution declaring the need for and authorizing the Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority to operate as a "Participating Administrative Entity" within the boundaries of the City of Prineville

WHEREAS, the Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority (for "Kitsap Authority") is a housing authority created and operating under Chapter 35.82 of the Revised Code of Washington ("RCW"); and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.82.070(13) provides that a housing authority may exercise its powers within the boundaries of any city, town or county not included in its area of operation if the governing or legislative body of that city, town or county adopts a resolution declaring that there is a need for the housing authority to function within the city, town, or county, as the case may be; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Prineville has determined that there is no entity within the City that is willing or available to act as a "Participating Administrative Entity" (PAE) in connection with the "mark-to-market" program of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Kitsap Authority has indicated that it is willing and has the capacity to so operate within the City; and

WHEREAS, HUD has designated, or it is anticipated that HUD will designate, the Kitsap Authority as the PAE for the City; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Prineville:

Section 1. Declaration of Need and Public Interest. The City Council of the City of Prineville declares that there is a need, and it is in the public interest, for the Kitsap Authority to operate as a PAE in connection with HUD's mark-to-market program with the City of Prineville.


Section 2. Authorization. The City Council of the City of Prineville authorizes the Kitsap Authority to operate as a PAE in connection with HUD's mark-to-market program within the City of Prineville.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval.
