

RESOLUTION NO. 831


A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CITY OF PRINEVILLE RAILWAY FUNDS FOR USE  
IN REPAIRING FLOOD-RELATED DAMAGE TO CITY OF PRINEVILLE-OWNED  
FACILITIES AND CROOK COUNTY PARKS


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Prineville that \$150,000 in railroad funds is hereby designated for use by city agencies and the Crook County Parks and Recreation Dept for cleaning up and repairing damage related to the flood of Memorial Day weekend, 1998, subject to the following conditions:

1. These funds are committed with the understanding that they will not displace any aid or assistance from any other agency of state or federal government;
2. Only expenses directly related to restoring conditions as they existed prior to the flood are eligible for reimbursement from these funds.
3. Restoration of city infrastructure shall have priority for the use of these funds.
4. These funds shall be used only within the city limits.
5. Funds shall be disbursed to the Parks and Recreation Department as reimbursement for expenses incurred.
6. The city manager shall provide quarterly to the city council an accounting for the disbursement of these funds.
7. Any funds not drawn by June 30, 1999 shall be returned to the railroad fund.
