Councilor Roppe asked about alarm permits and business licenses and whether they can approve the budget with the revenue from these items in it, without first approving ordinances creating business licenses and alarm permit fees. It was determined that the budget can be revised if and when these items are brought forward as ordinances. Mayor Wendel commented on surplus City Owned property and requested that those properties be considered prior to next year's budget and the impact on debt service to avoid rate increases. Councilor Roppe moved to approve resolution #1083, motion carries, all in favor.

A) Interim City Manager Contract Discussion: The Council discussed the proposal submitted by Wayne and determined that the Council had consensus that the proposal appeared to be acceptable to both parties. Legal will draft a contract to come back to the Council at the next meeting.
