

City of Prineville Snow and Ice Removal Plan 2024-2025

The City of Prineville Public Works Department has released its winter snow and ice response plan for the 2024-2025 winter season.

City Sanding - first response;

Priority #1 Lifeline routes (routes taken by fire, police, and EMS vehicles responding to emergencies) Loper Avenue, Oregon St., Hudspeth Rd., N/S Main St., Elm St., Combs Flat Rd., SE 5th St @ Hospital.

Priority #2 Schools, Fairgrounds Rd, Knowledge St., Fairview St, SE 2nd St, Lynn Boulevard, and NW 2nd St.

Arterials and Collectors; NW 9th, NE Laughlin, 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, Deer, Harwood, Rimrock, Gardner, Lamonta, Peters, Baldwin Industrial Park, Tom McCall Industrial Park.

Priority #3 Remaining Downtown Core Streets, minor collectors, and residential streets.

Snow removal when conditions present an excess of 5 inches of snow accumulation; Priority routes defined above will be cleared first. In the core area snow will be plowed to the middle of the street with removal taking place as soon as practical. The downtown core area consists of Deer St. to Fairview St. and 1st St. to 5th St. N/S Main will be plowed to the curb to allow center turn lane usage. Remaining streets will be plowed to the curb with minimization of driveway and alley blocking where practical. During prolonged snowfall, high priority routes will be sanded and plowed several times before moving to lesser priority routes.

Storm Drainage; After sanding and plowing are controlled, City workers will uncover storm drain catch basins and gutter lines to access storm facilities. As weather allows, the street sweeper will begin removing cinders to comply with air and water qualities.

Note; 3rd Street and Hwy 126/26, SE Combs Flat Rd and the grade are under ODOT jurisdiction.
